

Early Years Academy Emergency and Accident Procedures

We at Early Years Academy will provide the safest, accident free environment for your child that is possible. Our staff will conduct daily inspections of the center to avoid any potential hazards.

In the event that your child should become seriously ill or injured we will administer all of the first aid that is within our power, and will contact emergency medical care if it is deemed necessary.

We reserve the right to call 911 if we feel the situation is life-threatening. At this time, parents will also be notified and directed to either our designated clinic or hospital. Should your child need to be transported by ambulance, a staff member will accompany your child to the hospital and report back to the center for parent information, and will remain at the hospital until the family arrives.

In the event of a tornado the children will be escorted to their designated shelter areas. Please see the parent board for your child's area.

During blizzards and other weather emergencies, Early Years Academy follows District 911 guidelines for closure and will contact parents accordingly.
